The NDHRAF is a juried group exhibition open to all mediums and live performance work. All entries must be received by **midnight CST** on **Friday, November 29** to be considered. The NDHRAF reserves the right to extend deadlines when necessary. All entries must be original works by the submitting artist. If selected for exhibition, works must be mailed in or dropped off by **Friday, December 27** and be on display until **Wednesday, July 15**. The submission fee is \$25. Artists may submit up to two works.
